Menindaklanjuti surat Kepala Biro Kerja Sama dan Hubungan Masyarakat nomor 75459/A6/KS.03.01/2022 tanggal 30 Desember 2022 perihal permohonan diseminasi dan nominasi AUS4ASEAN *Short Course Programme*, kami informasikan dengan hormat bahwa RECOTVET memberikan informasi bahwa Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade di bawah proyek Aus4ASEAN *Digital Transformation and Future Skills* mengadakan program kursus singkat selama dua (2) minggu di Australia.

Kursus ini diperuntukkan bagi warga negara ASEAN yang bekerja di bidang Pendidikan dan Pelatihan Teknik dan Kejuruan (TVET) serta pengembangan keterampilan. 2 (dua) program kursus singkat yang ditawarkan adalah:

a. *Skills Forecasting for the Fourth Industrial Revolution*

Peserta akan mendapatkan pengetahuan terkait gap antara permintaan dan penawaran keterampilan, eksplorasi dalam memperkuat pasar ketenagakerjaan, eksplorasi cara dalam meningkatkan kapasitas pemerintah, institusi pendidikan dan pemangku kepentingan lainnya, serta hal-hal mengenai kemampuan dalam memperkirakan 4IR dan tren lain yang timbul di kawasan ASEAN.

b. *Improving the Digital Readiness and Resilience of TVET Systems in ASEAN*

Peserta akan mendapatkan pengetahuan terkait refleksi tantangan institusi TVET dalam menghadapi pembelajaran *online* selama masa pandemi, memahami mekanisme yang paling tepat untuk meningkatkan keterampilan guru TVET dalam pembelajaran, serta hal-hal mengenai peningkatan kesiapan dan ketahanan digital dalam sistem TVET terhadap gangguan, melalui pembentukan model alternatif dan fleksibel menggunakan teknologi baru.

Persyaratan yang dapat dipenuhi calon nominasi antara lain:

- memiliki pengalaman kerja setidaknya empat tahun dalam pemerintahan/pelatihan TVET;
- mengirimkan *curriculum vitae* yang menjelaskan tugas dan tanggung jawab yang diemban saat ini;
- menguasai bahasa Inggris dengan baik;
- mengirimkan surat izin dari atasan;
- memiliki komitmen untuk terlibat aktif dalam pelatihan; dan
- berkeinginan menyebarkan manfaat pembelajaran yang didapat dalam pelatihan.

Sehubungan dengan hal tersebut, kami mohon kiranya Saudara dapat turut berpartisipasi atau meneruskan informasi ini kepada unit organisasi maupun individu yang memiliki potensi untuk dapat mengirimkan nominasinya dan persyaratan sebelum tanggal **11 Januari 2023**.

Short course: Skills Forecasting for the Fourth Industrial Revolution

Call for applications

The Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, under the Australia for ASEAN Digital Transformation and Future Skills initiative, invites applications from ASEAN countries to attend a short course on **Skills Forecasting for the Fourth Industrial Revolution** in Australia.

The two-week short course is designed for ASEAN citizens working in the field of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and skills development. The short course will facilitate an exchange of expertise between Australia and ASEAN countries on skills forecasting for the Fourth Industrial Revolution and other emerging trends in ASEAN.

In Australia, the participants will have an opportunity to connect with Australian organisations and hear from leaders in the field.

The short course will be delivered in Australia twice, in **May and June 2023**.

The program consists of a two-week course in Australia and a one day online briefing session.

The course will help participants to

- Identify ways to support TVET regional mobility to strengthen the comparability of selected sectors in ASEAN and reduce the gap between the demand and supply of skills.
- Explore options to strengthen labour market information systems in ASEAN member states towards achieving greater labour mobility across ASEAN member states.
- Study and document best practices in assessing labour market needs and employment opportunities, linking with skills requirements of growing industries.
- Identify ways to obtain and use quality labour market information, including skills forecasting to support lifelong learning initiatives.
- Explore ways to enhance the capacities of governments, educational institutions, the business sector and other stakeholders to conduct skills forecasts to promote labour market-oriented education and training.
- Explore effective models of cooperation or sharing of learning management information between all stakeholders, including the private sector.
- Benchmark the Australian approaches for the workforce to move between the labour market and learning institutions to respond to changes in labour market demand (skills development, re-skilling and up-skilling).



The course is designed for **25 participants** from ASEAN countries, including representatives from governments, TVET training providers, associations and universities with experience and a relevant role in skills forecasting.

Requirements

- You are a citizen of one of these countries: Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.
- You have a bachelor's degree or higher qualification.
- You have at least four years' experience working in a relevant role in government, or with a TVET training facility, university or an industry association.
- You have professional working proficiency in English. The applicants' English language competency is part of the selection process. The assessment of language competency is based on a phone interview and any additional evidence provided by the applicant (proof of studies or living in an English-speaking country, working in an English-speaking environment, completion of studies in English, language courses or language tests).
- Your supervisor endorses your application.
- You are committed to engage actively and foster networks with multiple stakeholders.
- You are committed to sharing expertise with course participants and disseminating learning from the course with colleagues and peers.

Short course: Improving the Digital Readiness and Resilience of TVET Systems in ASEAN

Call for applications

The Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, under the Aus4ASEAN Digital Transformation and Future Skills initiative, invites applications from ASEAN countries to attend a short course on **improving the digital readiness and resilience of TVET systems** in Australia.

The two-week short course is designed for ASEAN citizens working in the field of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and skills development. The short course will facilitate an exchange of expertise between ASEAN and Australia on improving the digital readiness and resilience of TVET systems to disruptions, through establishing alternative and flexible models using new technology.

In Australia, the participants will have an opportunity to connect with Australian organisations and hear from leaders in the field.

The short course will be delivered in Australia twice, in **May and June 2023**.

The program consists of a two-week course in Australia and a one day online briefing session.

The course will help participants to:

- Reflect on the challenges TVET institutions faced in the shift to online delivery during the pandemic and the related quality assurance issues arising for governments.
- Determine the most appropriate infrastructure investments in digital systems to support digital TVET delivery with the aim of assisting in the potential development of an ATC digital platform.
- Understand the most appropriate mechanisms to upskill TVET teachers for enhanced digital learning; what skills do they need, how can these be delivered and how can skills be kept updated?
- Understand how governments and TVET institutions can best develop learning resources for online delivery and keep them updated.
- Identify opportunities to leverage existing training programmes that promote safe, responsible and appropriate use of ICT for teaching and learning (for students, teachers, school heads, educational managers), including promoting digital citizenship and educational technology leadership.
- Ensure the safety of users of digital learning resources and systems (cyber security, data privacy, etc).
